

Establishment of ICRFE and Centre for sustainable ecosystem and forest management.

The proposal was discussed in SAG on 04.01.2012 for diversion of 25 ha of RF land for establishment of ICFRE and Centre for sustainable ecosystem and forest management. It was informed that the proposal is necessitated to have better coordination with the Ministry and with the International Organization. The proposed area is degraded RF area which is suitable for administrative buildings and research plots and residential complex, the area is not part of any wildlife sanctuary or national park. ICFRE being central government undertaking, CA is proposed in double degraded forest land for which the land has been identified and suitability certificate is being furnished by the DFO. The proposal is for the research in the forestry, the SAG after deliberation recommends the proposal for approval.

Diversion of 7.329 ha of forest land for Granite dimension stone mining village Khoda.

The proposal has been discussed in SAG several times in past and State Government was requested to furnish the required information. In the last SAG meeting which was held on 09.11.12 the State Government was requested to furnish the information within 20 days or else the decision would be taken based on the information furnished by the user agency and the mining department. The information from the State Government is still awaited. The Special Secretary has assured that the required information will be submitted within 15 days as some clarification from the mining department is still awaited. The SAG is not happy with the response of the State Government. During the SAG meeting it was pointed out by the Nodal Officer that the proposal under reference is the second proposal which involved 7.29 ha of forest land in two Khasras one 63 and one 58. The earlier proposal submitted was for 4.7329 ha which was in Khasra No. 63 that proposal was turned down by the State Government citing the State Government order that the minimum distance of forest area from the mining should be 100 meters. The area under reference is the land which was given for compensatory afforestation against the Tehri Dam project of Uttarakhand. It was informed that the mutation of the land has been done in favour of forest department but the process of notification for declaring it as PF or RF is still pending. If the plantation in this area has been taken up is not clear and the C F who has recently joint the circle has asked some more time for site inspection. SAG is in favour of having the site inspection of the area to be taken up by the concerned CF and it is preferred that a joint inspection of the area with representative of MOEF should also be taken up. This inspection should be completed within one month time giving clear picture of suitability of land for mining, land proposed for CA against the proposed mining and present status of the land under reference whether it is suitable for CA for which it was given earlier. The proposal is deferred till then.

Widening and strengthening of Meerut – Karnal Road SH-82 by UPSHA

The proposal for diversion of 29.28 ha of forest land for widening and strengthening of SH-82 Meerut Karnal Road was discussed in SAG on 04.01.2013. It was informed during the SAG meeting that the total length of Meerut Karnal road is 87.5 Km. but the forest involved in this is only 12.4 Km – 11.4 Km is protected forest ( for the management purpose) one Km is through reserve forest. The width of the proposed widening is not given in the proposal and it is informed that ROW varies from 15 m to 36 m. The existing road width is also not given in the proposal. The user agency has assured that the details of the existing road and proposed widening required shall be submitted within a week time, justifying the area proposed for widening required. One bye pass is also involved for which no forest land is involved. The proposed road is also not crossing any railway line or canal except at Km. 14.6 where upper Ganga will be involved and that portion is already included in the proposed area requirement for widening. The average ROW is kept is 31 meters. For the four lane roads the ROW requirement is 45 meters. It is informed that ROW of 45 meter is not possible in this case as land is not available on both the sides the of the road. Therefore as per the IRC guidelines plantation on both the sides of the road will not be possible with the proposed ROW of 31 meters. To compensate the liner plantation as per IRC guidelines UPSHA is ready to taken up compensatory afforestation as per para 3.2 of FCA guidelines and has agreed to provide CA in equivalent NFL or DDFL. As per the plantation of number of trees involved in widening of this road the plantation of double the number is proposed in degraded forest land in patches has given in the proposal and for felling of trees in the reserved forest 10 times of the number of trees involved should also be taken up as forest land. Area is not part of any wildlife sanctuary or national park. The SAG after deliberation agrees to recommend the proposal for approval subject to furnishing the required information mentioned above.
