Diversion of 36.795 ha of PF for widening of two lane with pave shoulder from Km. 7.450 to Km. 130.100 in district Hamirpur, Mahoba and Kanpur.

The proposal was discussed in SAG on 21.03.2012. The total length of the proposed widening of NH-86 is 183.2 Km. which starts from Km. 7.45 at Kanpur up to Km. 130.10 at Tabrai in district Mahoba beyond Km. 130.10 the NH-86 merges with NH-76. Total tree felling involved is 21638. The existing ROW is between 14 meters to 42 meters which remains the same and only 1.5 meters on either side will be required for the widening purpose. After completion of the road the black top would be 10 meters and paved shoulder 1.5 meters on either side the remaining portion shall be used for plantation on either side.

The NHAI has agreed to take up the compensatory afforestation in double the trees involved on either side of the road. Also the remaining vacant area shall also be planted at the cost of user agency by the forest department. The NHAI would also provide the cost for establishing the nursery for the plantation, gap filling in future as well as distribution to the local people of a capacity of one lakh seedlings. The approximately cost of which will be Rs. 5 lacs. SAG after deliberation recommends the proposal on usual conditions.
