

Diversion of 10.595 ha of forest land for construction of dedicated freight corridor in district Etawah, Firozabad, Ramabai Nagar, Mahamayanagar, Agra , Auraiya, Mirzapur, Aligarh in Uttar Pradesh.

The proposal for diversion of 10.595 ha of forest land for construction of dedicated freight corridor involving the districts of Etawah, Firozabad, Ramabai Nagar, Mahamaya Nagar, Agra, Auraiya, Mirzapur and Aligarh initially individual proposals were submitted for each district which is now been converted into consolidated proposal. The entire area involved is forest land which is under the control of Forest Department. Total tree felling in forest land involved is 1646. it was informed that part of the project is also under TTZ for which approval of Hon'ble Supreme Court has been taken which involves felling of 4314 which is mainly outside the forest area for which the felling permission will be granted by the respective DFOs under Tree Protection Act. For CA non forest land has been provided which 8.657 ha have been marked in two districts i.e. Firozabad and Ramabai Nagar for which scheme has been submitted with the proposal. Gram Sabha resolution/ DM certificate has been submitted except in Mirzapur where DM certificate is wanting which was informed by the representative of Railways that will be submitted soon. All other information are furnished the SAG after deliberation recommends the proposal for approval.

Construction of Adwa Barrage submergence area in Mirzapur district, U.P.

The proposal for diversion of 27.19 ha of RF for the submergence area development for construction of Adwa Barrage in district Mirzapur was discussed in SAG earlier on 09.11.2012. In the last meeting the SAG has asked to user agency to furnish the pending information but inspite of lapse of more than 6 month the required information has not been submitted. On perusal of the proposal it is found that another proposal of 50.17 ha for the same purpose has been submitted to the Ministry for consideration. The SAG wants to know why a consolidated proposal has not been submitted since both the proposals are for the same purpose and the same area. The SAG wants that a combined proposal should be submitted to the Ministry directly and state government should withdraw under reference. Therefore the proposal is not been considered in this SAG.

Widening and strengthening of NH-24 from Hapur to Moradabad and felling of 630 tree.

The proposal was discussed earlier also in SAG on 09.11.12 and 04.01.13. The required information with regard to map and cross section of the road now has been submitted. The proposed 6.925 ha is PF for management purpose which is under the control of NHAI but since the area is part of the Hastinapur Wildlife Sanctuary the approval of NBWL and Hon'ble Supreme Court is also accorded. The road side plantation would be taken up for which space is available on the road side itself. For the future expansion of the road to six lane it has been already worked out that the required ROW of 60 m will be available at the time of widening of six lane and for which the area for plantation would be demarcated and plantation would be taken up accordingly so that at the time of taking up the project for six laning no damage of plantation takes place. The proposal after deliberation was agreed upon and SAG recommended for approval.
